Trip Destination	Disconnect all utility lines such as power cords and water lines.	Keep a lookout at all times for other boats, persons, and
Date	Take in all dock lines and fenders (protective devices used between the boat and other objects) except for those you will use in leaving the dock.	objects in the water. Keep a watch for low overhead wires.
		Proceed slowly whenever leaving or returning to a dock.
	Instruct passengers and crew to keep hands, arms, etc., inside the boat.	Use just enough power to maintain control.
